

COVID 19 INFORMATION

Bridgagate Physiotherapy Clinic is open and seeing patients for face to face assessment and treatment. The Chartered Society of Physiotherapy has release the following statement:

- “The CSP is keen to reassure members and patients that physiotherapy services across the UK can remain open no matter what level of lockdown restrictions their area is subject to. This includes private and independent sectors”

Many of the previous infection control guidelines initially advised by Public Health England, UK Government, The Chartered Society of Physiotherapy and PhysioFirst (the organisation for physiotherapists in private practice) have now been relaxed. However, we are still following a lot of the infection control measures we put in place to minimise the risk of COVID-19, other infection illnesses and keep our patients and staff safe.

Clinical staff are not required to wear PPE anymore (mask, apron, and gloves) but are happy to do so on patient request.

Clinical rooms are still sanitised between each patient.

Communal areas are still cleaned regularly throughout the day.

Patients are not required to wear a mask whilst in clinic anymore, but we are happy for you to wear one if you prefer.

We do still ask that all patients to use hand sanitiser gel on arrival.
